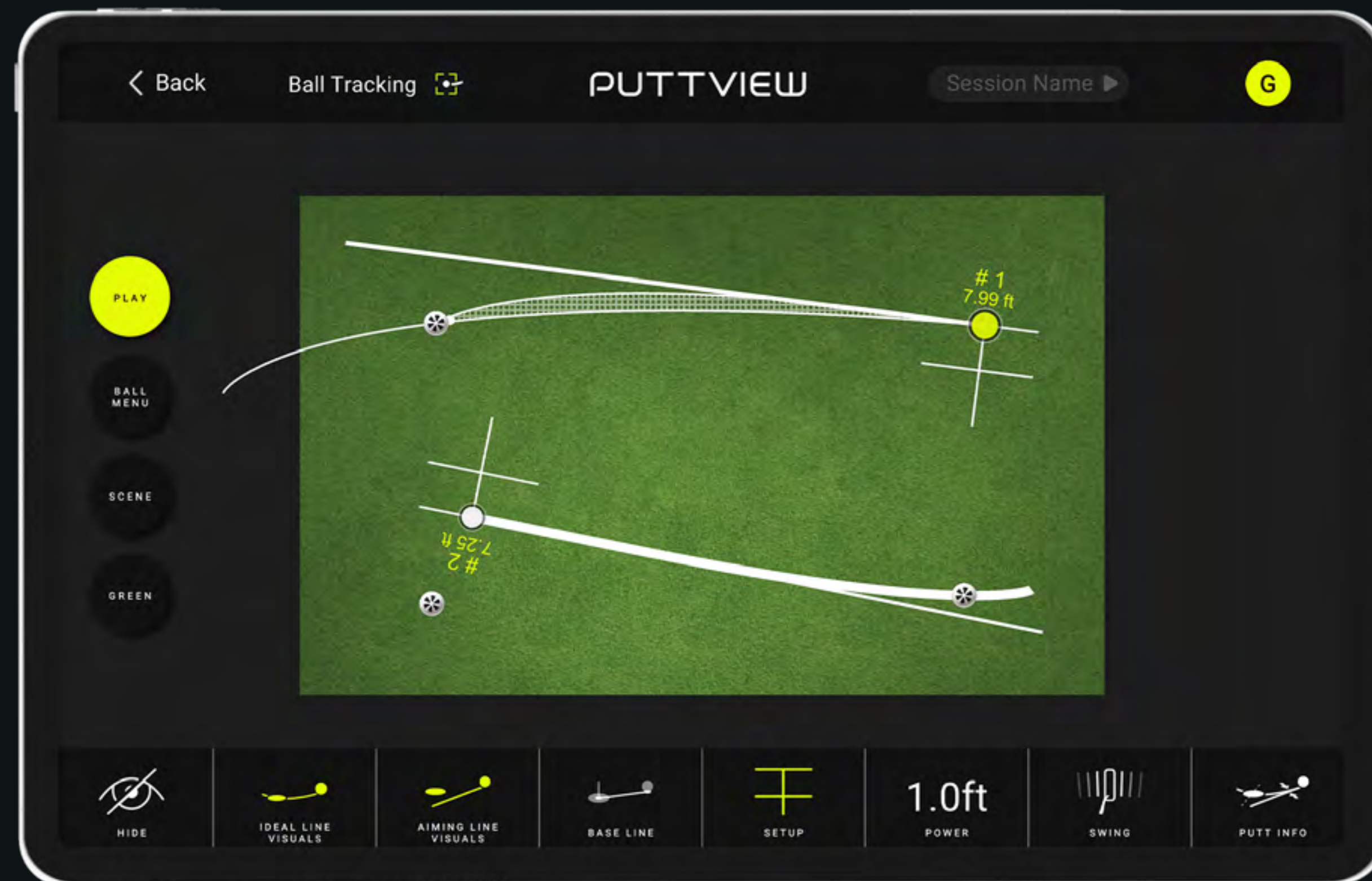

See the Green in 3D

The Contour Lines visualize all slopes on the green like in a topographic map. The lines connect points of equal elevation and enable you to quickly identify the slopes of the green. The Contour Lines help you to understand the impact of gravity and read breaks better on the course.

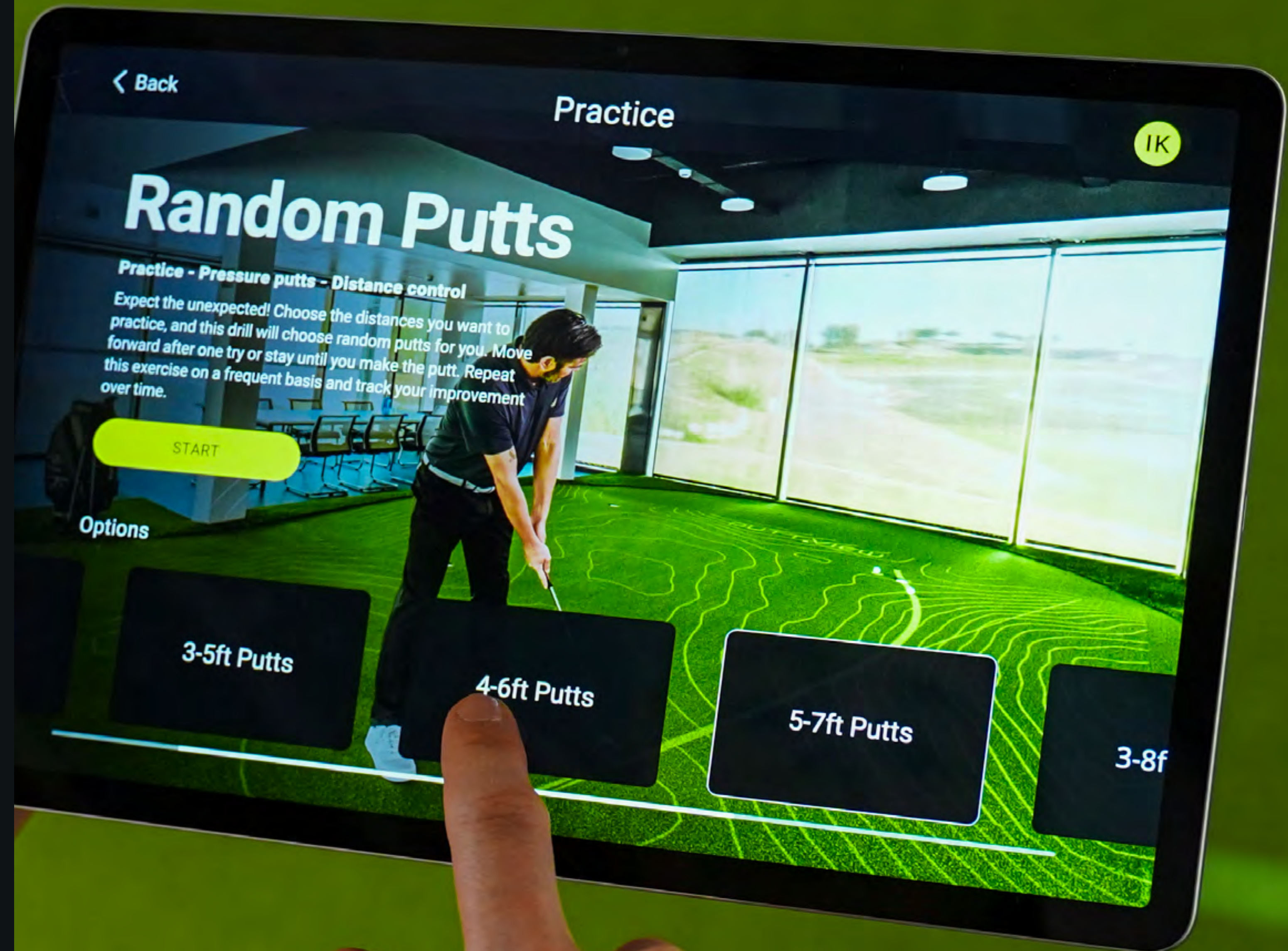
